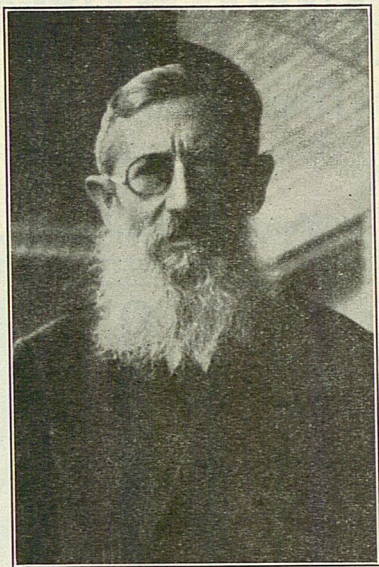


Farewell Reception for Rabbi J. Hurvitz

Rabbi Hurvitz is leaving Pittsburgh, having accepted the position of rabbi and spiritual leader of the Jewish community and congregation of the city of Lynn, Mass., where he will assume his duties on September 1st.

Rabbi Hurvitz is considered in the rabbinical world one of the foremost talmudic scholars of the age. He is the author of many talmudic and exegetical works, still in manuscript, and is considered an authority on Hebrew law.
